Annual Catholic Appeal 2024: All parishioners in the Diocese of Madison should have received in the mail a letter from our Bishop and a pledge form for this year's Annual Catholic Appeal. For example, part of the monies donated are given toward Catholic Charities. They provide many services in Dane County and throughout the diocese. They offer counseling services, assist the homeless, and run the Mobile Food Pantry, which allows people in rural areas access to produce, meat, and other necessities. Pastorate Name News: Last month, I invited parishioners of the pastorate to offer suggestions for our new name for the pastorate, which all 3 parishes will be merged into one canonical community. The voting time was extended until the end of January due to all the inclement weather our area experienced. The Implementation Committee and I then gathered to count the 120 ballots. Out of all the suggestions, the top three were: St. John Paul II, St. Jude, and St. Francis of Assisi. Those three names, along with their rationales, were submitted to Bishop Hying for his consideration. Thank you to all who participated, and I extend my gratitude for the help of the Implementation Committee.

Lent starts this Wednesday: Ash Wednesday is this coming Wednesday, February 14. Please remember that it is a day of fasting and abstinence from meat. The Lenten regulations and Ash Wednesday Mass times are included in the bulletin.

Finally, we welcome Bishop Hying, who has been kind enough to visit our pastorate. He celebrated Sunday Mass last weekend at Holy Redeemer, Perry. Next Saturday, he will be presiding at the Saturday night 5:00 PM Mass in Ridgeway. We are grateful for his pastoral ministry.
